The law states that we can store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site. For all other types of cookies we need your permission.


This site uses different types of cookies. No cookies are placed by third party services on our pages.

CGA use the following cookies to assist in the ease of use of the online flex system.


The data is used within a single session to ensure security and visual fluidity while navigating through the flex system

2	PHPSESSID	Primary	Session	<p>A security feature which keeps track of the unique session token and registers this when loading data to ensure that not unauthorised external access is attempted. In the case of an</p>

invalid token being referenced in a session the user is notified, ejected from the system and a log kept of each instance.
